LOLLIPOP THEATER



Fun ology: A zone of fun filled but critical thinking simple science activities.


Digital Poster: A zone of digital presentation on developments in space technology.

SWIMMING GALA




The Swimming Gala took place on 18th October, 2016 for KG-1 and 19th October, 2016 for KG-2 in the Kindergarten pool.
