Subject- ID cards & Uniform Readiness message from Principal

Dear Parents,

As we are now operating under the KHDA "Back to School" Protocols we will be moving to on-site learning only from **Sunday 3rd, October 2021**.

To give parents plenty of time to prepare for on-site learning there are a couple of requirements that need to be 100% in place from the parent and student point of view.

1. Parent and student ID cards need to be current and ready for the abovementioned start date. If you do not have an ID card for any reason e.g., lost, damaged, yet to purchase... you will need to arrange payment for the issuance of a new ID card at the accounts department in the main foyer of Springdales school.
2. All students will be required to adhere to the school uniform policy without exception from the 3rd, October. This gives parents approximately one month to ensure your ward is presented to a standard that meets our strict uniform policy. Our policy is clear, if a student does not arrive in full uniform they will receive a verbal warning, then a written warning with detention, then an escalation to far more serious consequences.

We are excited to be moving rapidly towards a time when students are engaged fully on-site and as a consequence online learning in its current form (live online classrooms, blended learning) will cease. This is a new beginning in which students can come to school every day and experience all that Springdales has to offer.
