Thank you, parents, for your understanding and patience during the past week as we navigated our way through the latest Covid issues. As you are well aware we decided to move into online learning as a result of the rapidly rising cases and the situation that the Omicron strain has caused in the UAE. I am pleased to announce that our proposal to remain online until Friday 14<sup>th</sup> has been approved by KHDA.

## Procedures from Commencement of face-to-face/onsite learning:

- The teachers and students are expected to be back in school for face to face/onsite learning from Monday 17<sup>th</sup> Jan.
- On returning to school all teachers and students (students from grades 1 to 12 only)
  must produce a PCR negative test report before coming onsite on the 17<sup>th</sup>. Students
  must submit the soft copy of the reports to their respective class teachers.
- The students and teachers who have a PCR positive report from Monday the 17<sup>th</sup> will be considered as special cases and will be allowed to take lessons/attend learning from home until they are cleared of the isolation/quarantine period along with a valid PCR negative report.
- Students without PCR positive report are expected to be present in school and if absent from campus will be removed from Teams.
- Please note that the KHDA guidelines only allows the online option to specific cases.
- The school will take all preventive measures to safeguard the health of the students and we request the parents to take all precaution at home as well.
