Dear Parents,

Thank you, parents, for your understanding and patience during the past two weeks as we navigated our way through the latest Covid issues. I am pleased to announce that KHDA have supported and congratulated us on returning to face-to-face learning this coming Monday.

**Procedures from Commencement of face-to-face/onsite learning:**

- The teachers and students are expected to be back in school for **face to face/onsite learning from Monday 17<sup>th</sup> Jan.**
- On returning to school all teachers and students (students from grades 1 to 12 only) must have a PCR negative test report. .
- Students must submit the soft copy of the reports to their respective class teachers a day prior (16<sup>th</sup> Jan 2022). All those tested positive or haven't submitted the PCR report will not be allowed to board the bus or enter the school premises
- The students and teachers who have a **PCR positive report from Monday the 17<sup>th</sup>** will be considered as special cases and will be **allowed to take lessons/attend learning from home** until they are cleared of the isolation/quarantine period along with a valid PCR negative report.
- **Students with PCR negative report are expected to be present in school** and if absent from campus will be marked as absent and removed from Teams.
- Please note that the KHDA guidelines only allows the online option to specific cases.
- The school will take all preventive measures to safeguard the health of the students and we request the parents to take all precaution at home as well.

The following safety protocols from KHDA have remained in place for at least one more week:

**KHDA Updated protocols**

We are working with Dubai government authorities and monitoring changes daily. For the time being, the changes implemented at the start of the year will continue:

- all PE lessons, organised trips, events and internal gatherings, such assemblies and performances, should be put on hold
- extra-curricular activities taking place at school, either within or outside of official hours, should be put on hold
- Canteens or cafeterias must be closed and shared eating spaces not be used

These rules are in place to minimise the spread of Covid-19, and to ensure that students are still able to benefit from face-to-face learning.



We will also strictly adhere to the current KHDA guidelines below until such time that KHDA inform us otherwise including the DHA guidelines pertaining to APPENDIX 5: MANAGEMENT OF COVID-19 BY HEALTH AND SAFETY TEAM (HST)
