Culinnovation-Innovation in Cooking



Father's Day


Father's Day is considered extremely important as it help acknowledge the contribution of fathers to individual families and to societies as large.

Global Awareness



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


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Science Week

This year we celebrated World Environment Day on 9th June, 22 with a feel for what the day is all about, by singing songs, colouring pictures, planting seeds and various other activities.



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


The aim was to infuse the students with appreciation, understanding, love and usage for the language. The week turned out to be an extremely experience engaging mix with fun for the children.

Every show and tell session is interesting and a thrilling experience for the kids sharing their feelings with peer which provides a fun and comfortable learning arena for everyone involved.








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Awareness about the Holy Month of Ramadan

Our Goal is not just an environment of clean air, clean water and scenic beauty. The objective is that of decency, of mutual respect for all other human beings and all other living creatures.



These concepts will be embedded in their daily learning. It was heartening to see students' participation and enthusiasm throughout the time involved in the math activities. An enriching experience for all!
























Picasso Art Competition

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

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
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PTM


